

Between 1963 and his death in 1973, Rev. Louis O’Kane tape-recorded the stories of former Irish Volunteers from Ulster half a century earlier. These recordings are now held in the Cardinal Ó Fiaich Library and Archive, Armagh, and were the subject of the ‘Reflections on the Revolution in Ulster’ conference that was hosted in the library in November 2015. This publication contains the papers presented at that conference, and is illustrated by various images from the O’Kane collection.
